

Council for Children and Adolescents With Chronic Health Conditions

Parent Training/Conference Fund Request Guidelines

The Council for Children and Adolescents with Chronic Health Conditions was formed to address issues that impact the lives of children with chronic health conditions. Modeling the Area Agency System in New Hampshire that provides services to individuals with developmental disabilities; the Council was designed to meet the needs of children whose primary medical condition is a chronic health condition and who are not able to receive services from an area agency.

The types of trainings or conferences which are funded are ones which serve the primary purpose of providing information specific to the chronic health condition. In some capacity attendance at this training or conference must serve to improve the ability to manage the chronic health condition and improve affected individual's access to the community. The maximum amount granted for these grants is \$1000/calendar year.

Who may apply?

- Parents or guardians of a child with a chronic health condition
- Children who have a chronic health condition
- Professionals who work with a child with a chronic health condition.

****Camp Scholarships****

The Council for Children and Adolescents with Chronic Health Conditions is also offering scholarships for children to attend camp. This camp must have an educational component that helps deal with a chronic health condition. Some examples of these camps would be, Obesity Camp, Diabetes Camp and Hematology Camp. The maximum amount granted for the camp scholarships would be \$250. Payment must be made directly to the camp involved.
